

# Search for a UIC Realignment

## Overview


The UIC Realignment Search process provides the ability to search for a UIC and realign the UIC to a new site or Accountable UIC. The process also allows changes to the UIC ID or the Major Command Code. Access to the process is role-based. The role required for access is the UIC Realignment role.

## Navigation

Master Data > UIC Realignment > UIC Realignment Search page

## Procedures

### Search for a UIC Realignment

One or more of the Search Criteria fields can be entered to isolate the results. By default, all results are displayed. Selecting  at any point of this procedure returns all fields to the default "All" setting.

1. In the Search grid, narrow the results by entering one or more of the following optional fields.

## Realign a UIC

- Click  to select the entry. The UIC is highlighted, and  becomes available.
- Select . The **Realign UIC** pop-up window appears.

### Procedures

#### Realign a UIC

Selecting  at any point of this procedure removes all revisions and closes the page. **Bold** numbered steps are required.



1. Select . The **Realign UIC** pop-up window appears.

The UIC realignment will generate transfer accounting transactions if applicable.

This is a "lead" UIC, meaning its UIC matches its Accountable UIC. Changing the UIC will also change the Accountable UIC to match.

**Note**

The UIC Transfer-generated message appears with all realignments. The "Lead" UIC message appears when the selected UIC is a match of the Accountable UIC.

2. Complete the *SITE ID* section.

**Note**

The data fields become available based on the level of access.



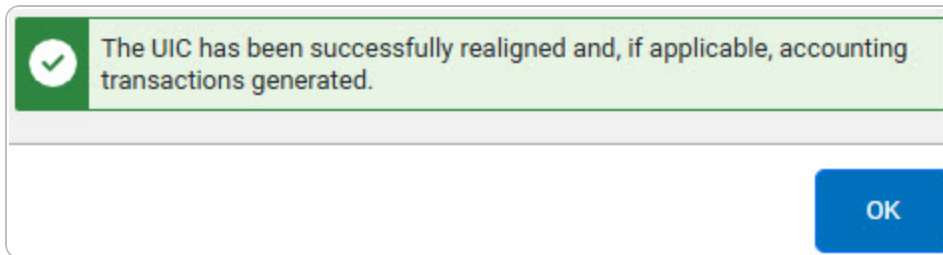
## Help Reference Guide

Example: If access is only granted to one SITE ID, then the SITE ID field is not editable. If access is granted to multiple SITE IDs, then the SITE ID field becomes editable with the available SITE IDs.

This applies to all SITE ID, Accountable UIC, UIC, and Major Command Code fields.

3. Complete the Accountable UIC section.
4. Complete the UIC section.
  - A. Enter the To in the field provided. *This is a 6 alphanumeric character field.*
5. Complete the Major Command Code section.
6. Complete the Attachments section.
7. Complete the Remarks section.

8. Select . The



pop-up window

appears.

9. Select . The **UIC Realignment Search** page appears.

### Helpful Tip



To confirm the Realignment, select . The available and realigned UICs display in the Search Results grid.
