#### **Release Notes Overview**

Release 2022.1.7 for the Defense Property Accountability System (DPAS) was released on July 29, 2022.

This release includes System Change Requests and corrects program deficiencies identified by the user community. The update impacts the Maintenance and Utilization and Warehouse Management modules.

# Maintenance and Utilization (M&U) Module

## **Help Tickets**

The following Maintenance and Utilization Help Tickets were closed by this release:

### Schedule Preventive Maintenance Auto Generate Work Order (WPSAB52)

#### Help Ticket #60799

Corrected a deficiency where a Work Order was voided, and the schedules for them were still being generated.

#### Help Ticket #69377

• Corrected a deficiency where Work Orders were not being generated promptly, due to a discrepancy in the Schedule Effective Date being adjusted for the local time zone of the user.

#### Help Ticket #68938

• Corrected a deficiency where Work Orders that auto generated many Sub Work Orders, are not creating the correct amount of Maintenance Schedules.

### Help Ticket #66534

• Corrected a deficiency when Preventative Maintenance Schedules were scheduled for an asset with Work Plans tied to them and the Work Order was populated, not all the Work Plans were being populated.
