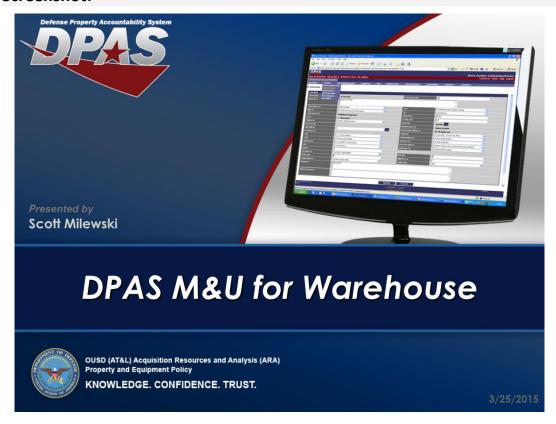

Participant Questions and Comments:

1. **Question**: Will there ever be any vehicle related webinars? **Answer**: That topic will be scheduled for later in the year.

2. **Question**: Is there a way to input additional information with an NSN? Example: NSN for a Dodge Bobtail may be 2510013541234, but we currently use a vehicle registration number for tracking purposes.

Answer: Yes, you would add that when creating the Stock Number. Do you use the VIN as the serial number? If not, there are other areas where additional information can be added.

3. **Question**: Receiving will add this asset to the property book?

Answer: Correct, after the Work Order and Quality Control (QC) processes are complete, it will be added to Warehouse's inventory.

4. Question: What about Authorizations and such?

Answer: These assets are stored in the Warehouse module not the PA module. Authorizations are handled differently in the Warehouse Management module.

5. **Question**: Is it possible to track bench stock items associated with a Work Order in DPAS that can be pulled in its own report.

Answer: The Work Order inquiry and Work Order Journal can be used to pull information about past Work Orders.

6. Question: Does M&U work with PA?

Answer: Absolutely! The method of getting assets into the M&U module is a little different, but once in the M&U module, the assets can have Work Orders created, be Dispatched, have Utilization tracked along with Warranty, Service and Subscriptions.

7. **Question**: Good morning, I am a Multi Class Warehouse Manager. I heard your comments regarding Warehouse cataloging and receiving but will there be training provided for other vital Warehouse functions such as Warehouse Inventory, Retrograde, and Issue of items from Warehouse stock.

Answer: Yes, there will be several other processes covered in the upcoming months. These will include: Cataloging, Receiving, Individual Issue & Return, Sets, Kits & Outfits (SKO), Unit Issue & Return and Materiel Release Order (MRO) just to name a few.
