Overview



- SKO Assemble Purpose
 - Identify and build component Inventory within the warehouse into a kit as defined in the SKO Catalog process
- Two ways to assemble a Kit
 - Pick Plan and Pick Process
 - SKO Assemble (SKO Streamline)



- Pick Plan and Pick Process
 - Kit components are in different locations
 - Kit Assembled in different location
 - Kit Stored in different location



- SKO Streamline
 - Bypasses the pick plan and pick processes
 - Components are located in the same place as the kit assembly and storage



- Steps to accomplish before SKO Assemble
 - Create a SKO Catalog record to define the kit components
 - Create Stock Item record for each kit component and the kit header
 - Receive component inventory into the warehouse
