

Participant Questions and Answers:

Question: How does the Requisition or "Mark For" info get populated

Answer: All of the information that is displayed on the form will be directly related to the matching DPAS

transaction. Depending on your transaction's data will determine form data population.

Question: are the forms the same for individual issue as we saw for unit issue?

Answer: Yes, individual issue will also provide the capability to print Issued Items and Outstanding Items Forms

Question: you use the % sign like %pants and it pulls all

Answer: No, the % wildcard is only a Property Accountability function.

Question: Some of your reports you was showing, a few of them, isn't showing up within my DPAS would it be because of my user role?

Answer: Yes, depending on your DPAS role and level of access within your DPAS agency - this can determine what reports are available for you to access.

Question: I'm not quite sure of the difference between the "data compilation" of scheduled reports and the "data rollup" of real-time reports. Would you mind going over that difference again, or perhaps define what "rollup" means?

Answer: The scheduled reports will provide report data based off of the report parameters you as the user set and schedule - you can determine whether the data is from today or from another day. Whereas the Real Time reports will report data based off of the date and time of the system when you select "run report" - giving real time inventory data of that given day.

Question: Can the inspection type/interval be added to the stock number inquiry? We are trying to find what items are bulk managed and have an inspection loaded, so we can improve our data.

Answer: If those data fields are not current column options within that inquiry, then the addition of those data fields would require an System Change Request to be submitted to be worked.


Question: Are there any special permissions required to run these reports? Can any DPAS WM user run these reports as long as they have access to the DoDAAC/UIC?








