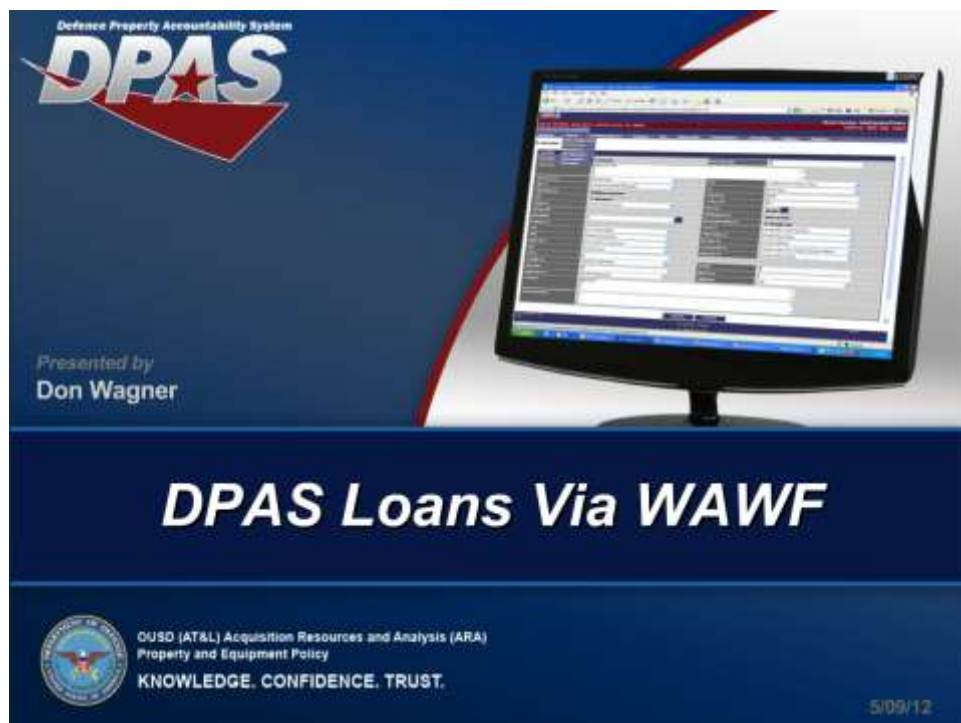

Participant Questions and Comments:

QUESTION: We are an RDTE site and loan out items of all different dollar amounts for testing.

ANSWER: \$5000 is not a requirement for IUID but is a reference amount.

QUESTION: I would like to know more about Contractor Acquired Property (CAP). Whom may I contact to find out more about this topic?

ANSWER: You may find the Defense Acquisition University (DAU) on-line course: *CLC051 Section 889 - Managing Government Property in the Possession of Contractors* beneficial.

QUESTION: Will we need to do a new registration for WAWF if we have one already?

ANSWER: Not if you have the Shipper and Receiver role.

QUESTION: I have the Web DPAS IUID Requirements from a past Webinar, but would like to have a presenter provide this Webinar again in the very near future.

QUESTION: Where did the Asset Id come from?

ANSWER: Asset Ids are assigned when an asset is received.

QUESTION: Wondering if WAWF or DPAS allows automated KO/PA approval of the GFP transfers?

ANSWER: You will need to do acceptance in WAWF, it will then flow to DPAS.

QUESTION: Did you say we must have a Shipper and Receiver role in the IUID registry to have the connection between DPAS and WAWF established?

ANSWER: You will need a username with a Shipper and Receiver role in Wide Area Workflow (WAWF).

QUESTION: If we have items we need to loan that do not qualify for IUID marking, will we use this same process?

ANSWER: If you are loaning serially managed items, they will likely need to have a UII and would use this process.

QUESTION: Is the UII verification with the IUID registry done through an automated interface between DPAS and the registry?

ANSWER: Yes it is. If you had DPAS create a virtual UII it will automatically verify. If you manually associate or use AIT to associate a vendor UII, DPAS will verify the UII is valid in the IUID Registry.

QUESTION: Is the term GEX another way to say terminal?

ANSWER: GEX is the Global Exchange. It is a service that transforms data from one format to another.

DPAS Loans Via WAWF

QUESTION: Can spares be considered as materiel if consumed?

ANSWER: Government Furnished Material (GFM) is any item that is consumed into another item.

QUESTION: I have many rack mountable items on my hand receipt but the only rack mountable descriptions do not lead to the actual property description. Like a 3U rack mountable floppy/CD player. I am not able to supply a more detailed description.

ANSWER: You may choose to use the DPAS field called Sys Id to group your assets under one system id.
